- (1) To pursue a second degree, the second degree must require at least 15 credit hours beyond what is required by the already earned or in-progress degree program.
- (2) A second degree must result in significant academic and/or employment advantages.
- (3) Before pursuing a second associates degree, students must first consult with
 - a. FLCC’s Financial Aid Office to receive a Financial Aid Planning Worksheet which will explain the financial implications of pursuing a second associate’s degree, **AND**
 - b. for current students or students who are returning after less than a six-year absence, Academic Advising, Career & Transfer Services;
 - c. for students currently attending, the academic department chairperson or program coordinator for the new degree, if required—see reverse
- (4) **A student pursuing a second degree will be required to certify their intention to complete the degree requirements in full. Per education law, pursuing a second degree for the sole purpose of obtaining financial assistance is not permitted.**
